

Post Family Farm Picnic Games and Prize Information

Note: Prizes for these games are the responsibility of your organization.

Age Group One (4 & under)

- Duck Pond - Kids pick three floating ducks out of a tub. Each duck has a number (1, 2 or 3) on the bottom. Children receive one prize based on their total score.
 - Please provide three equivalent prize buckets (3 or 4 points; 5 or 6 points; 7, 8 or 9 points) from which each child will select one prize from the designated bucket.
- Flower Pot Toss - Just like the old bucket toss from Bozo the clown, we line up three flower pots and give each child three bean bags. They toss their bean bags into the pots and receive a prize for the most difficult flower pot they hit.
 - Please provide three graduated prize buckets (flower pots one, two and three). Each child will receive one prize from the highest possible bucket.
- Penny Hunt - Kids can hunt for buried treasure in our wood shavings. You provide the coins; we provide the wood shavings and a timer! The children keep the change they find as their prize.
 - Please provide coins, in any amounts desired, for the children to search for and "pocket."

»Prize summary«

We suggest age appropriate trinkets for boys and girls, and candy. Each child should walk away with two prizes and whatever change they find.

Age Group Two (entering grades K-3)

- Flower Pot Toss - Just like the old bucket toss from Bozo the clown, we line up three flower pots and give each child three bean bags. They toss their bean bags into the pots and receive a prize for the most difficult flower pot they hit.
 - Please provide three graduated prize buckets (flower pots one, two and three). Each child will receive one prize from the highest possible bucket.

(Age Group Two cont'd)

- Penny Hunt - Kids can hunt for buried treasure in our wood shavings. You provide the coins; we provide the wood shavings and a timer! The children keep the change they find as their prize.
 - Please provide coins, in any amounts desired, for the children to search for and "pocket."
- Round-up-Relay - The children are divided into two teams and then find a partner. One child gathers tennis balls that have been scattered around while riding in a wagon pulled by their partner. Once they drop their tennis balls into a basket, the next partners "round-up" some more tennis balls. The team that gathers the most tennis balls in the allotted time wins!
 - Please provide prizes for the 1st place and the 2nd place teams.

»Prize summary«

We suggest age appropriate trinkets and candy bars. Each child should walk away with an individual prize, a team prize and whatever change they find.

Age Group Three (entering grades 4-7)

- Rubber Chicken Toss - In this more "mature" version of the Flower Pot Toss, kids grab a rubber chicken and have three chances to toss it into three baskets. They receive a prize for the most difficult basket they hit.
 - Please provide three graduated prize buckets (baskets one, two and three). Each child will receive one prize from the highest possible bucket.
- Tractor Tire Relay - For this game, kids are divided into teams to compete against each other. Each team is given a large inner tube. The object of the relay is to place 2 (or 3!) people in the inner tube at a time, race around a pole, give the inner tube to the next "team," and so on until everyone on your team has competed. The first team to cross the finish line wins!
 - Please provide prizes for the 1st place and the 2nd place teams.

(Age Group Three cont'd)

- Sack Races - Each person grabs a feed sack and hops toward the finish line. The top three finishers receive a prize. (Optional: We can also run sack races as a 3-legged race where partners compete or as a team relay.)
 - Please provide prizes for the top three finishers, as well as a participation prize for everyone. (If you choose an optional format, please provide appropriate prizes.)

»Prize summary«

We suggest age appropriate games, candy bars, and outdoor toys for winners.

Each child should walk away with an individual prize, a team prize and a participation prize. Three children will also receive a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place prize.

Age Group Four (entering grade 8 - adult)

- Select two of the following four team games in which everyone can participate: Volleyball, Wiffle ball, Ultimate Frisbee or Kick Ball. These games are run tournament style and prizes for 1st and 2nd place teams or participation prizes are optional.
 - Please provide 2 sets of 1st place and 2 sets of 2nd place team prizes as well as participation prizes as desired. We suggest candy and candy bars and outdoor toys.

Parent/Child Games

- Three-legged Race - Grab a partner, a feed sack and off you go. The top three pairs receive prizes.
- Egg Toss - Choose an egg to toss to your partner, take a step back and do it again. The three pairs who catch an egg in the air from the greatest distance receive a prize.
 - Please provide 2 sets of 1st, 2nd and 3rd place pairs prizes. We suggest gift certificates to an ice cream or video store, and outdoor toys for winners.
